A legacy of Innovation

Chaigeley School has one of the most fascinating origins of any school in the UK. Founded in 1945, it was the first residential school for children with behavioural, emotional and social difficulties to be officially approved under the Education Act 1944. Its home, Greenfield House, was built in 1775 for the Stanton family, who ran a gunpowder mill in Thelwall. After serving as a military-requisitioned building during World War II, it became the new site for the pioneering Chaigeley School in 1946. Today, the school still proudly reflects its Quaker principles of respect, individuality and community.
