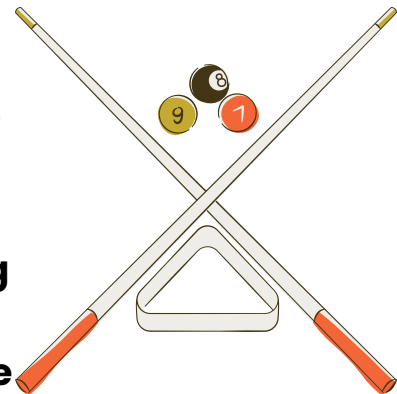
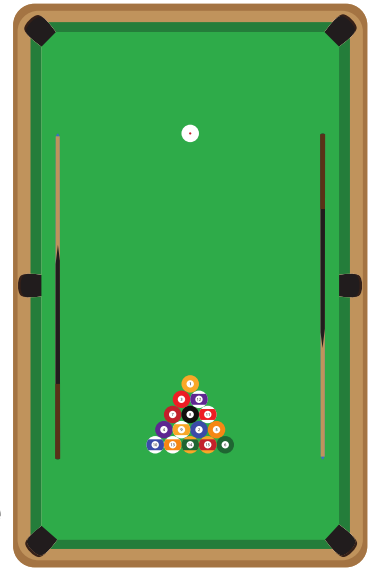


On Thursday, we were delighted to welcome Carl Morris and Richie B to school for a special pool session with some of our students.

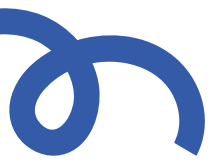

Dave is now looking forward to putting his new skills and knowledge into practice by delivering engaging Forest School sessions for our students.

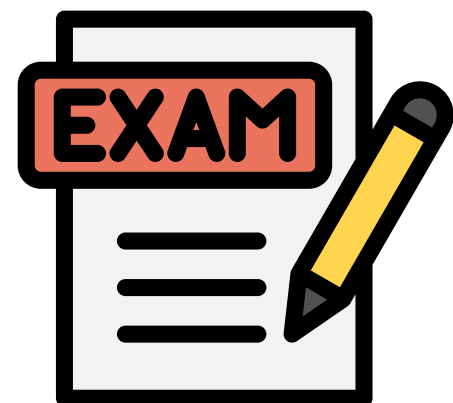
